



Discussion on following points done during the workshop

A) National Employability Report, Engineering Graduates – 2014 and 2016 only 18.33% of the engineers are employable. The 82 % engineering graduates are weak in programming and algorithm skills, soft and cognitive skills, domain skills, English speaking and comprehension skills and analytical and quantitative skills. Recently National Association of Software & Services Companies (NASSCOM) and other private firms surveyed that only 25% graduates in India are employable.
