2. Plants growing on the pond.

This pond consists of limited type of plants growing on the water. The pond mainly consists of green algae, blue-green algae, water lettuce, etc. as the water is used for drinking purpose, the pond is cleaned once in month by Nagar Palika of Bambvade and private NGO's so the percentage of growing of plants on pond are less.

3. Animals in the pond.

The pond consists of variety of small fishes, small prawns, lata fish, toad, frog, tadpole, snail, leech, crab, checkered kill back snake, etc. In winter season the pond gets full with various types of birds mainly the migrated bird species. Differ from that the local bird species like Little Egret, Ducks, Geese, Swans, White throated Kingfisher, Red wattled lapwing, Purple heron, Painted Stork, etc. are found around this ponds area.
